Excursion to Voith

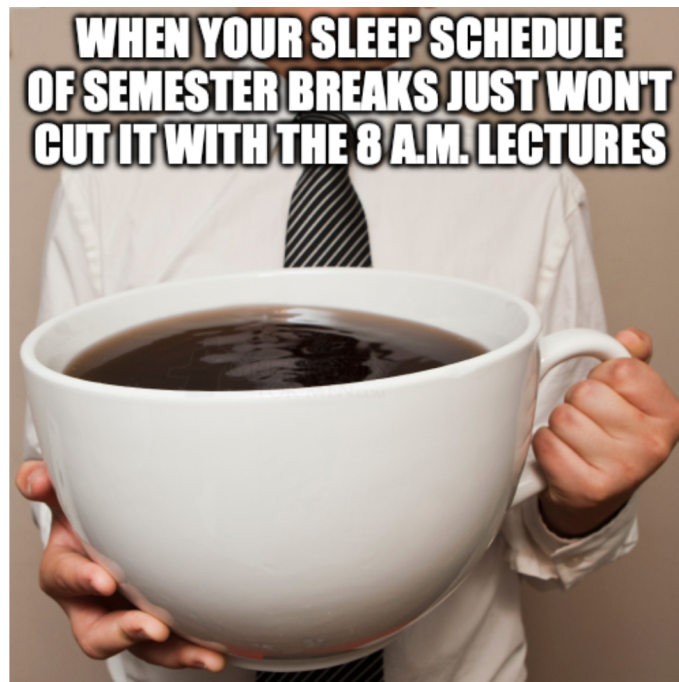
